Subject: Food King Refrigeration - air leaks

Question: What can we do to solve an air leak at the return air duct on the Food King model 427?

The refrigeration unit will need to be pulled out of the unit to gain access to the air duct seal (gaskets). Check the gaskets to ensure they have not been damaged. Follow the instructions below to install the refrigeration system inside the machine.

1. A piece of thin plastic or poster board that measures 8" x 32" will be needed for installation.
2. Lubricate both sides of the installation tool with a food grade lubricant or soapy water (example, Ivory dish detergent). Lubricate the gaskets with the same material.
3. Lay the tool on the top of the refrigeration unit and be sure it covers the gaskets.
4. Move the refrigeration unit into position being sure the tool slides in with the assembly.
5. Be sure the refrigeration unit is positioned correctly then remove the tool.
6. Secure the refrigeration system.
