## IARP Rotary Cooler Coupling Sleeve

Models Affected: All IARP Coolers

**Reason:** To provide instructions on installing the new polycarbonate coupling sleeve.

Order:1 – 0431207 Shelf Shaft Polycarbonate Coupling Sleeve

## **Installation instructions:**

1. Orient the Coupling Sleeve so the open side is towards the front of the Cooler.



- 2. Remove all product from all of the shelves in the Cooler.
- 3. Remove power to the cooler by turning the toggle switch at the back of the cooler to the off position (see "2" in Figure 1) or by unplugging the Cooler.



- 4. Open the glass doors completely by,
  - a. Pushing the button marked with a "1" and rotating it down.
    - i. Counter clockwise on the right door.
    - ii. Clockwise on the left door.
  - b. Once lock tab clears cabinet pull door open.



5. On the bottom shelf remove the Stopper marked with a "2" in Figure 4.

- 6. Lift the bottom shelf up close to the shelf above it and insert a Shelf Support Bush Bolt to hold it in place.
- 7. Remove the hardware (wing nut, flat washer, & toothed washer) from one side of the Shelf Shaft Blocking Journal. See Figure 6.
- 8. While holding on to the Aluminum Profile Shelf Shaft (see Fig 5) pull the Shelf Shaft Blocking Journal from the Coupling Sleeve (see Figure 1).



- 9. Carefully pull the top of the Aluminum Profile Shelf Shaft forward to reveal the nut securing the Coupling Sleeve to the shaft.
- 10. With a 13mm socket remove the INOX Nut securing the Coupling Sleeve to the shaft.
- 11. Remove the existing Coupling Sleeve and discard.
- 12. Install new Coupling Sleeve so the open side is towards the front of the Cooler.
- 13. Install the INOX Nut removed in step 10 and tighten using 13mm socket.
- 14. Carefully position the top of the Aluminum Profile Shelf Shaft in the Coupling Sleeve and insert the Shelf Shaft Blocking Journal removed in step 8.
- 15. Install the hardware (wing nut, flat washer, & toothed washer) removed in step 7. Apply Loctite to the threaded ends of the Shelf Shaft. See Figure 6.
- 16. While holding the bottom shelf in place, remove the Shelf Support Bush Bolt installed in step 6 and lower the bottom shelf back to its original position.
- 17. Install the bottom shelf Stopper removed in step 5.
- 18. Apply power and test for proper operation before loading product.
- 19. If test OK, remove power, install product, close and latch glass doors, and apply power.
