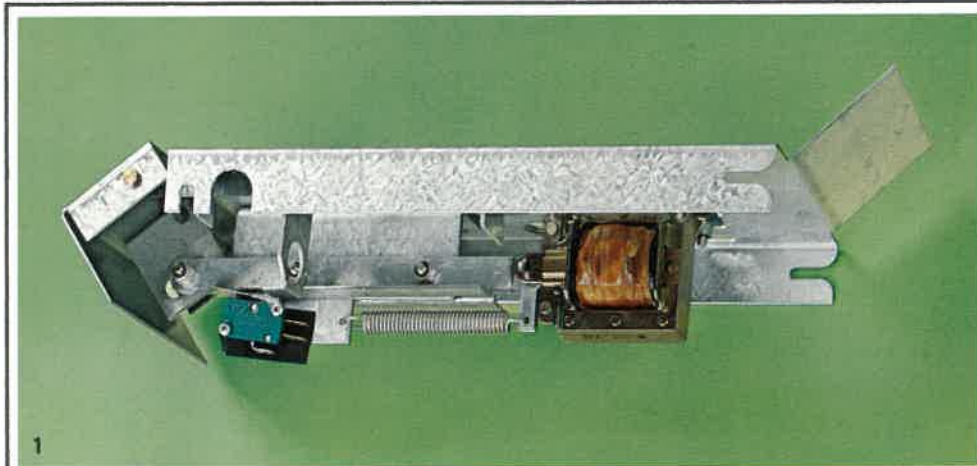

Some of the reasons why Dixie-Narco gives you more for your money, due to long life, less maintenance and minimum out-of-service time.



1. Simple vend mechanism

— heavy-gauge, galvanized metal construction with a minimum of moving parts, features an oversized solenoid with automatic reset type protection, instead of a one-time fuse.

2. "Neon" lamps — long-lived "sold out" and "correct change" lamps have no filament to break; cut bulb replacement, service costs and "temper" damage to door.

3. Wire vend racks — for quieter loading, cans roll on sides instead of rims, on galvanized steel wire forms; fold-down shelf makes for faster, easier loading.

4. "Quick-New" Vandal Panels — 12-gauge, galvanized steel panels riveted to cabinet wall and bolted to door side, conceal gasket joint; easily replaced on location, to restore new look if vandals strike.

5. Refrigeration system — complete refrigeration system and control are easily reached from the front; oversized evaporator cools rapidly.

6. Foamed-in-place insulation — greater cabinet strength with increased damage resistance, lighter weight, higher insulation efficiency and more vending capacity for a given floor area is provided by polyurethane foamed-in-place insulation.

7. Double security door — two rugged, reinforced doors eliminate joint cracks on front of cabinet to discourage vandals; access to coin box from between doors. Accessory lock holds doors together, allowing product loading only.

8. Corrosion resistance — top, sides and all external parts of cabinet and door are made from galvanized steel, especially designed to resist ocean spray.
