MODELS AFFECTED: All Coca-Cola Venders


REASON: To provide extra strength and security to the coin insert.

Order the parts needed from the list provided.



1 - 000,005,89x.x6	Flat Coca-Cola coin insert cover without correct change light hole
1 - 000,010,10x.x6	Flat Coca-Cola coin insert cover for coin-less venders
9 - 900,201,17x.x1	Carriage bolt, ¼ - 20 x 1"

9 - 900,800,67x.x1 Nut, ¼ - 20



INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Unplug the vender.
- 2. Place the coin insert cover to be used over the coin insert.
- 3. Align all the cover openings with the openings and parts affected on the coin insert.
- 4. Ensure that the T-Handle pops out cleanly. Adjust the cover if necessary at this time.
- 5. Using the cover as a template, mark the holes to be drilled.
- 6. Remove the cover from the insert.
- 7. Drill the required 5/16" ID holes.

Caution: Be careful not to drill in to any wiring, parts, or accessories.

- 8. Place the cover in position and secure with carriage bolts and nuts.
- 9. Test the T-Handle, coin return plunger, coin slot for coin insertion, and correct change light for proper operation.
- 10. Plug in the vender and test for proper operation.
