**REASON:** To provide parts to deter vandalism through the coin cup to the changer coin fill tubes and

payout switches.



### FOR VENDERS SERIALIZED 0001-6000CD TO 0001-6281DT WITH ONE-PIECE PLASTIC HOPPER & CHUTE:

ORDER: 491,010,840.04 Hopper Cover Kit

Kit Contents: 1 - 491,050,14x.x3 Anti-theft Cover

2 - 900,902,29x.x1 Tinnerman "U" Clip



#### TO INSTALL:

- 1. Locate the Coin Hopper and Chute.
- 2. Slide the anti-theft cover on the hopper as shown in figure 2.
- 3. Bend the top flange (A) down so the two corner tabs are on the outside of the hopper. See figure 3.
- 1. Secure the anti-theft cover in place with two Tinnerman clips. See figure 3.





## FOR VENDERS SERIALIZED 0001-6281DT AND HIGHER WITH ONE-PIECE SKIRTED HOPPER AND CHUTE:

**ORDER:** 1 - 491,050,17x.x3 Anti-theft Plate

2 - 901,100,61x.x1 Pop Rivet, <sup>1</sup>/<sub>8</sub>"

#### **TO INSTALL:**

1. Locate the Coin Hopper and Chute.




Figure 1 Figure 2

- 2. Open the top flap (A) of the hopper as shown in figure 1.
- 3. Refer to figure 2 to measure and mark 2 locations to drill \(^1/\_8\)" holes.
- 4. Drill holes.
- 5. Refer to figure 1 to rivet anti-theft plate to hopper flap.




Figure 3 491,050,17x.x3
